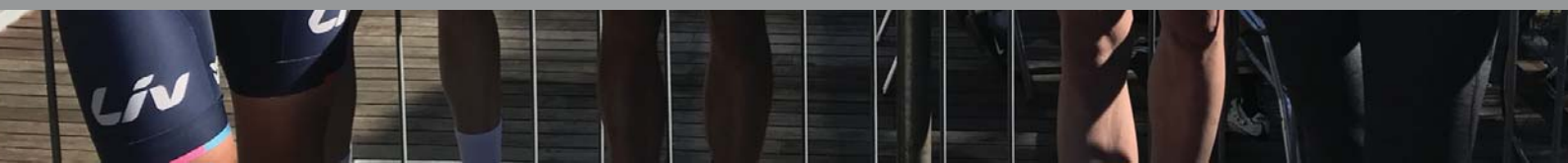

Spares & Clothing

Neutral Service will be provided for A Grade Men's and Women's by appointed VRS/NRS team vehicles.

All other categories may be allocated a tail car in which wheels can be placed for wheels in/out policy, subject to volunteer availability.

If you have someone able to help with providing a tail car we'd love to hear from you karin@ksjevents.com.au

It is highly recommended that riders carry their own spares to avoid delays from tail cars who will be following the last rider of each grade.

It is also highly recommended that you place a bag with warm clothing in the lead car of your race category.

All cars will be assembled adjacent to the start in both Warragul and Noojee marked with their grade signage.

****NOTE Rear Tail lights, visible from 200m and working during the entire event, are compulsory for all categories.**

Feed Zone - 105km race only

Feed zone is located at the Neerim Junction township, 46km mark of the 105km race, feeders must ensure they feed between the 'Start' and 'Finish' signs. A bidon dropoff/collection point will be made available. **Fines apply if taking on food or drink outside this .**

Extreme caution to be taken for vehicles travelling to finish from feedzone/Noojee to finish as there are limited passing opportunities.

Directional maps to feed zone and race finish are displayed on page 12 of this guide.

Medical

Medical cover will be provided by Event Medical Services Australia who will have two medical vehicles in the convoy.

Parking

Parking at the Mt Baw Baw resort is free - fees only apply during the ski season.

Race Conditions

The Mt Baw Baw Resort Baw Baw Classic is conducted under the road rules and regulations of the State of Victoria.

Riders must endeavor to finish unless a mechanical problem prevents them from continuing or they are directed by a commissaire or event official that time limit has been exceeded.

Riders caught littering, ie discarding of bidons or food/gel wrappers will be fined \$100 and disqualified.

Any fines imposed on riders by the Chief Commissaire may also carry a fine from the Victoria Police.
Riders must obey the direction of all Victoria Police officers, traffic controllers, marshals, race officials.

Due to the narrow roads, it is of utmost importance that riders keep left. The final 6km climb is held on a closed road however riders must still use extreme caution in case of traffic leakage.

Support vehicles asked not to follow the race course where practical and should use the alternative route direct route from Warragul. Fines will be imposed for not adhering to this request.

Limited transport will be available for riders who need transport back to start area, if you require this service please register your details at the registration desk. Cost: \$10.

Any Competitor caught urinating within view of the public will be disqualified from the race and fined \$100.00.

A sag wagon will be following the race should you not be able to continue.

A cut off time will be enforced at 12noon at Noojee, 56km point and again at 2.00pm at Tanjil Bren 10km from the finish. At this point you may complete the race course but will be deemed a DNF.

Should you decide to continue to ride you will not be supported by any race officials and will need to be self-sufficient

Race Numbers & Transponder Position

Attach race numbers to your left and right jersey pockets. Frame numbers should be attached to the rear brake bridge or seat post. Transponders should be attached low on the front fork using two zip ties. Numbers must not be cut, folded or modified in any way.

Transponder timing will be used to ensure accurate results. Failure to return your transponder will result in a fine of Bib numbers, frame plates and transponders need to be returned at the event. Late return (later than 7 days), lost or damaged transponders will result in a fine of \$150.

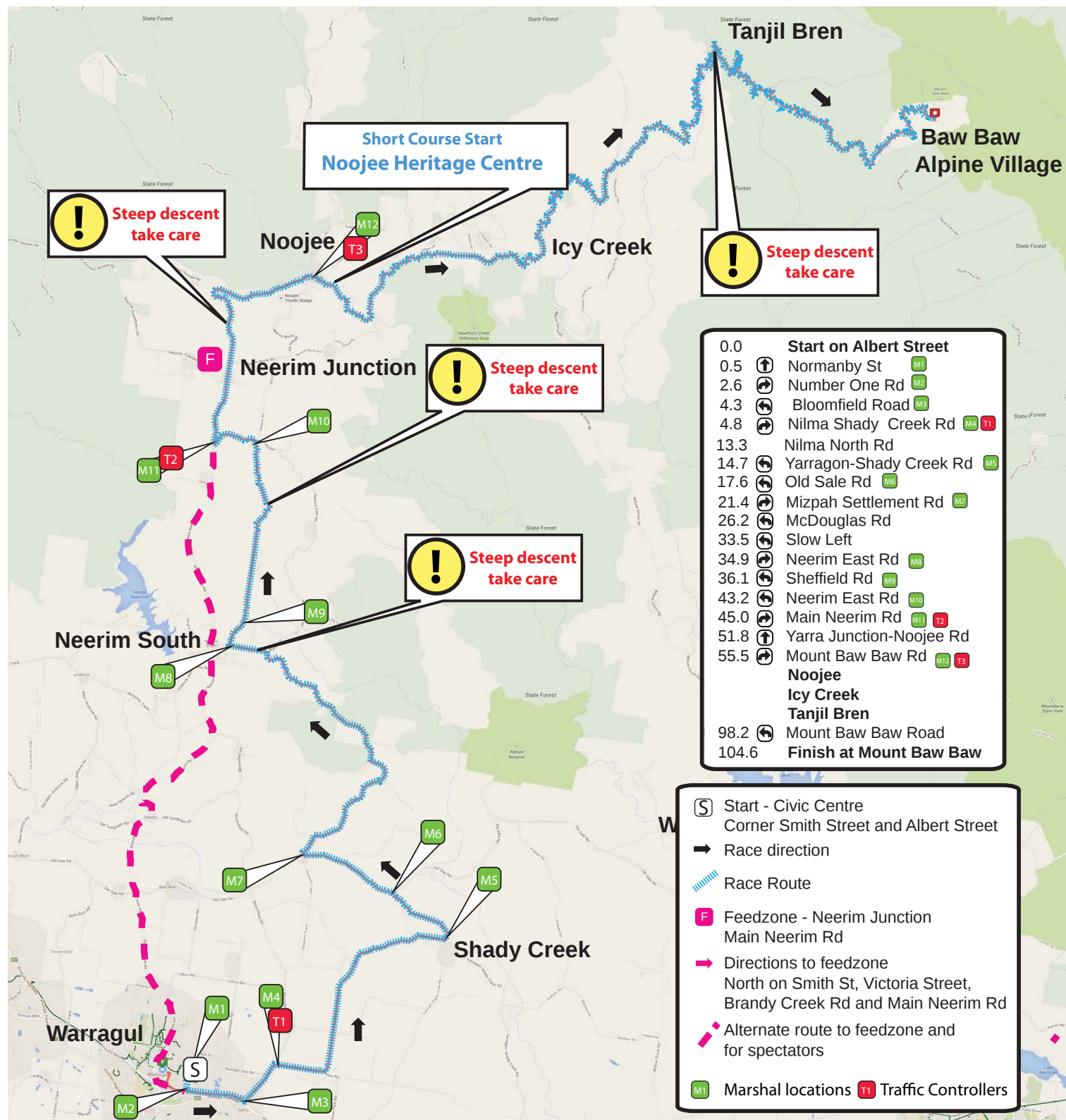

Non Convoy Support Routes

1. Warragul Arts Centre to Feed Station.

Head west along Albert Street

Turn right at the traffic lights onto Victoria Street (becomes Brandy Creek Rd)

Continue for approx 29ms until Neerim Junction Hall (on left)

Park in Neerim Junction Hall carpark

2. Feed Station to Baw Baw Village

Head North on Main Neerim Road

At T intersection, turn right onto Mt. Baw Baw Tourist Road

Turn left at intersection of Mt. Baw Baw Tourist Road and South Face Road - approx 48kms

Park in main car park immediately before the finish gantry

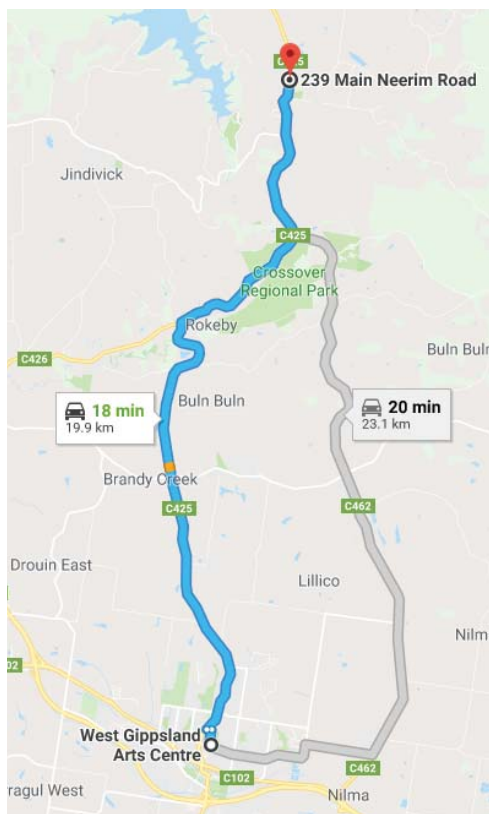
3. Noojee Heritage Centre to Baw Baw Village

Head along Mt. Baw Baw Tourist Road

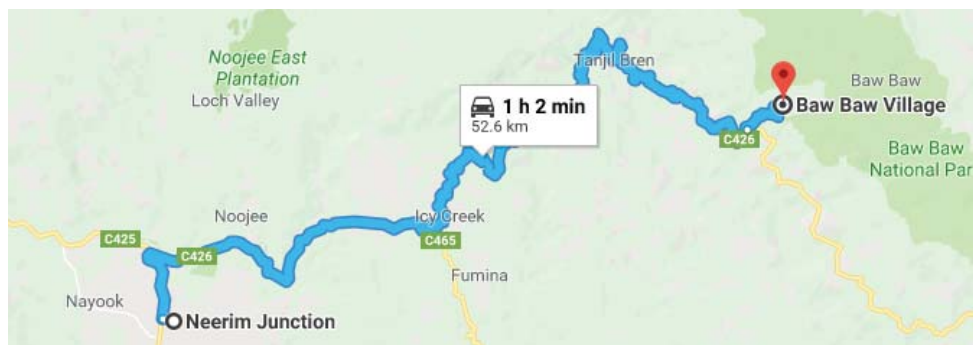
Turn left at intersection of Mt. Baw Baw Tourist Road and South Face Road - approx 43kms

Park in main car park immediately before the finish gantry

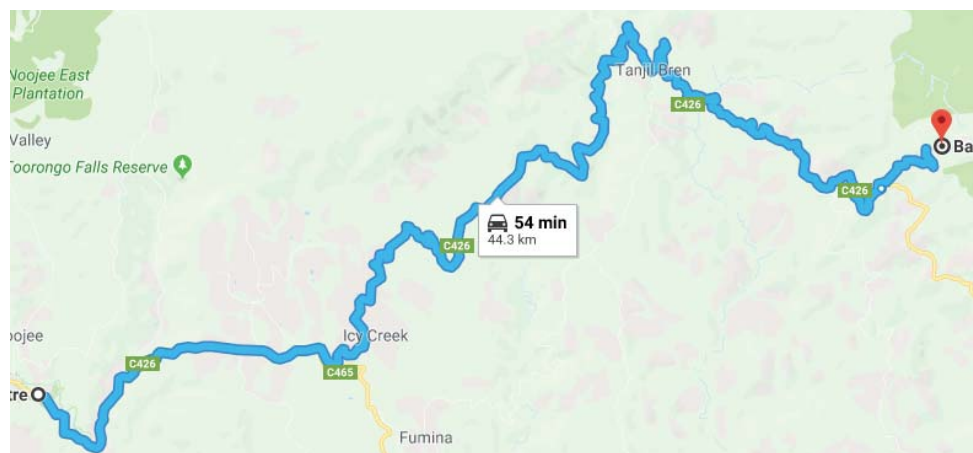
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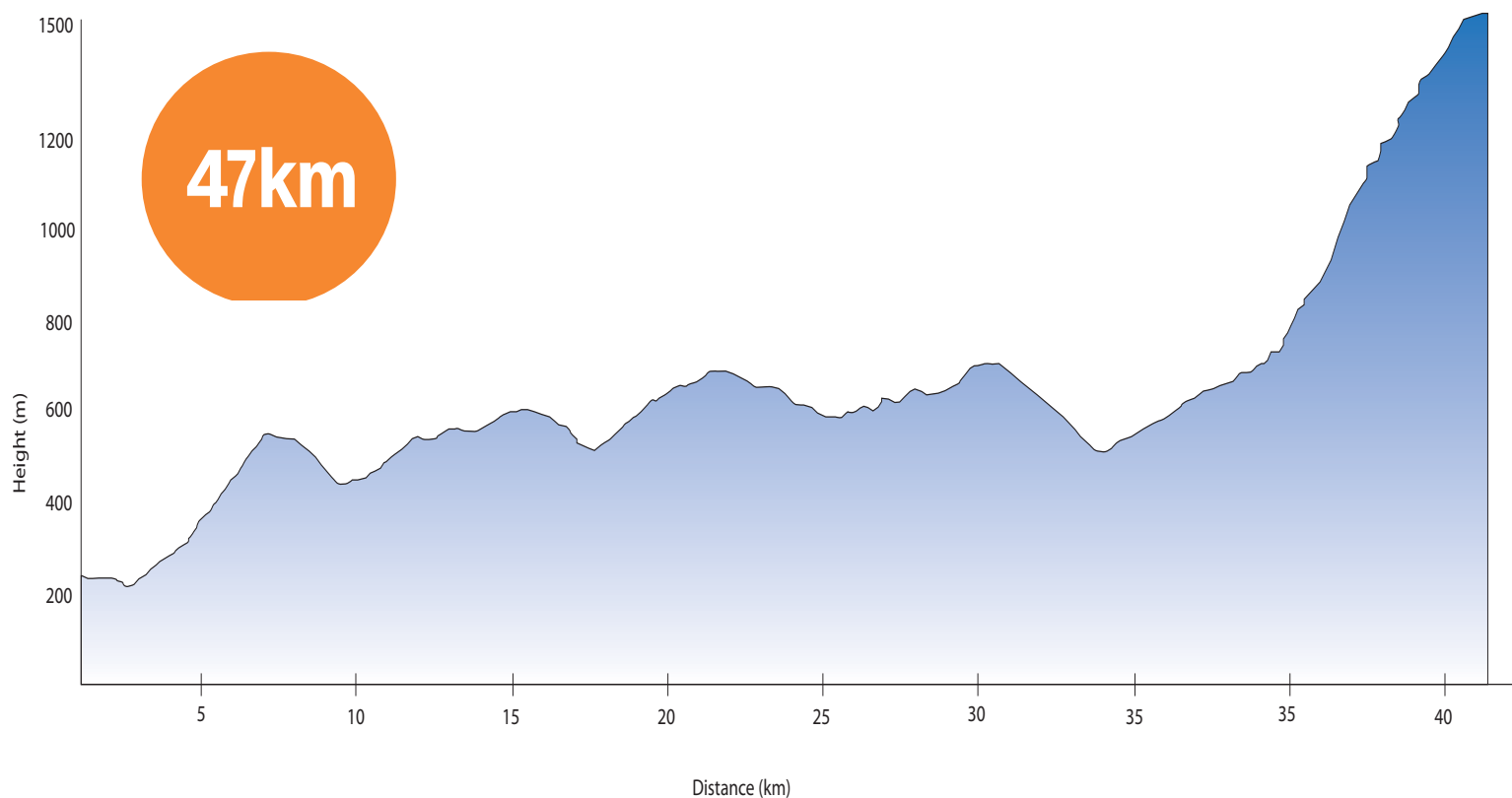
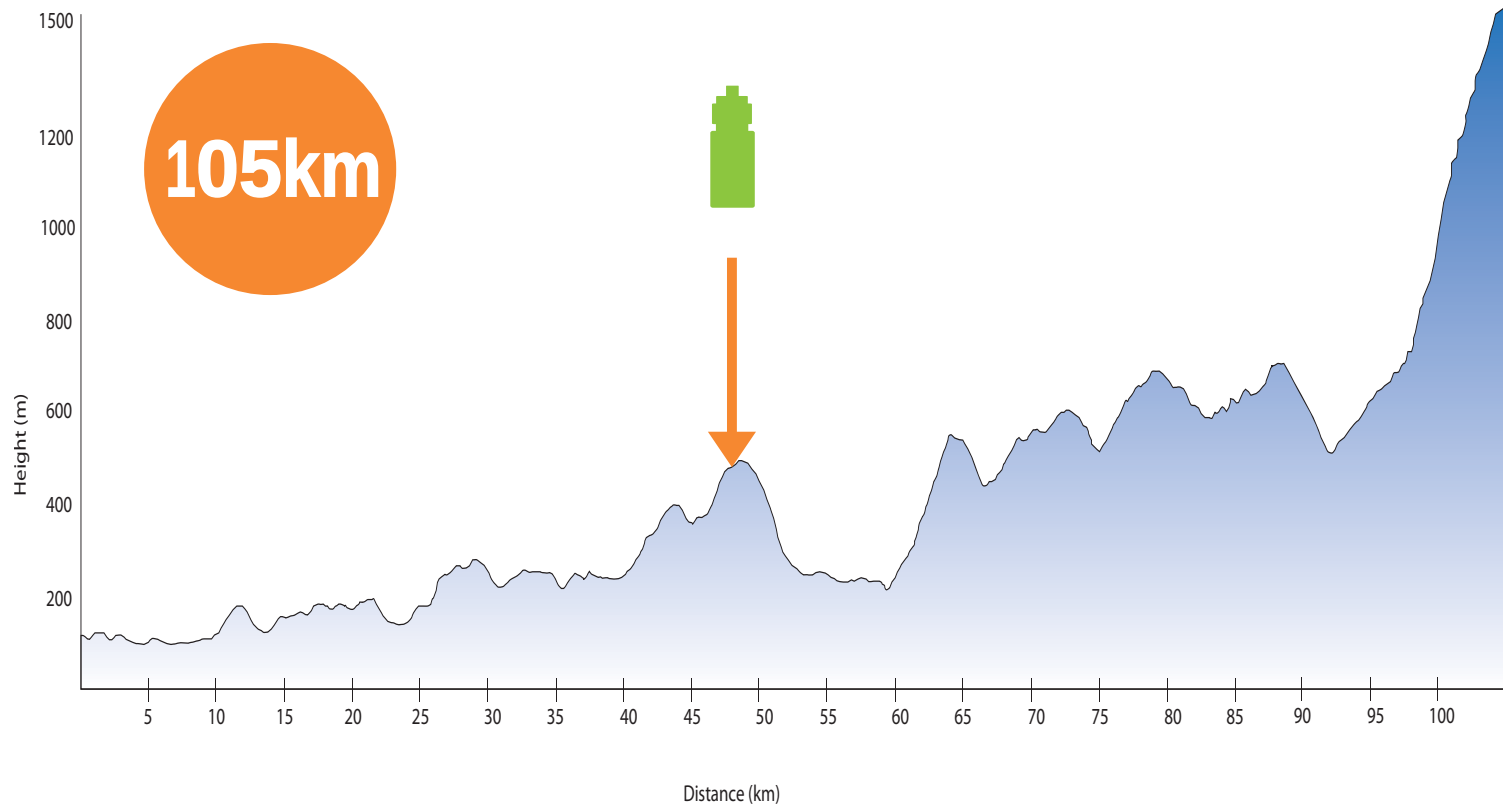

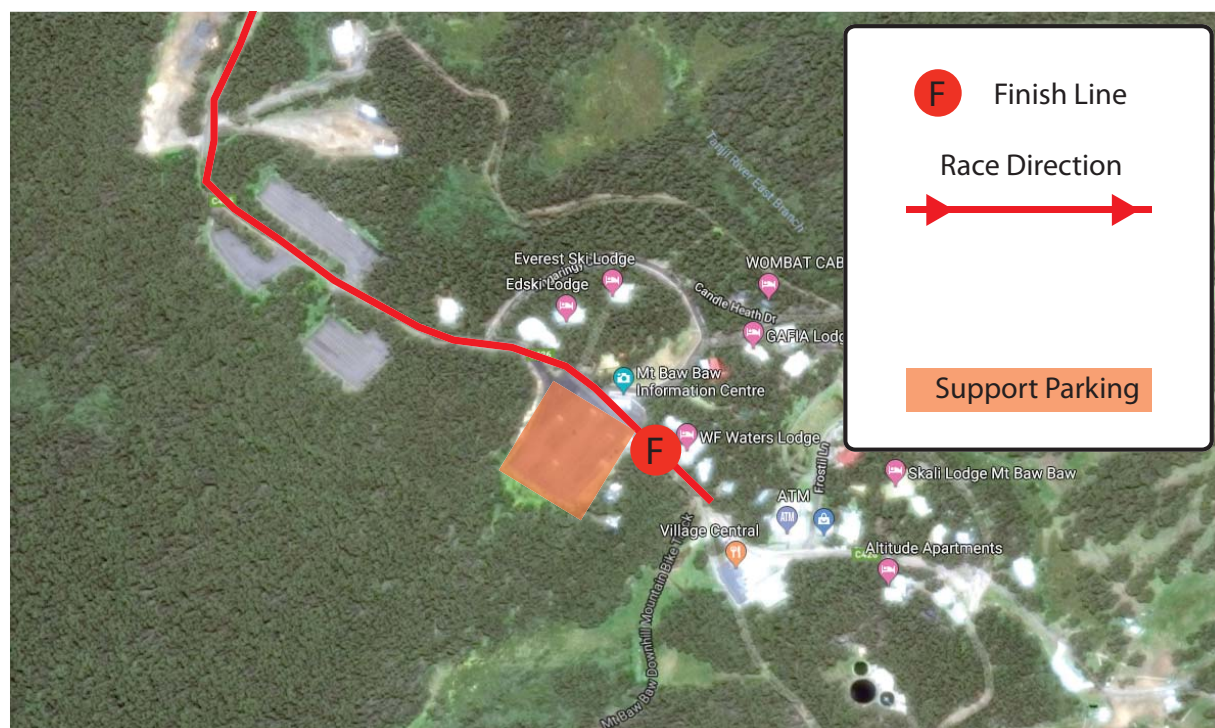
Feed Station - Neerim
